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To ensure a proper install, please read this article at least once **before** attempting to install your Windshield Banner or Window Sticker. An install should take about 15 to 20 minutes to complete and should be done indoors or a place that is shaded with minimal wind. The ideal air temp should be above 50 degrees. If below 50 degrees, please allow sticker to adhere to vehicle for at least 24 hours before driving vehicle.

Items Needed

Before you start the installation make sure you have the following items available:

- A friend or family member to help you
- Alcohol
- Low friction squeegee
- Lint free towels
- Blue Painter's Tape
- Heat Gun or Hair Dryer

Once you have this simple list of items gathered together, the next step is to prepare the vehicle

Vehicle Preparation

It's best to have just washed the vehicle as any dirt, wax, or debris will be detrimental to the quality of the finished install.

Vehicle Preparation (continued)

1. Wash the outside of the glass/area with soapy water at least two times to ensure all dirt is removed
2. Clean around the trim and surrounding panels
3. Wipe everything dry with alcohol & lint free towel (do this a couple of times)

Banner Installation

With the vehicle prepared you are now ready to continue with the install!

1. Don't forget your friend or family member to help you with the next steps
2. On hard flat surface, use your squeegee to press on the transfer tape and vinyl. Start in the center & work your way to outer edges, removing any excessive bubbles
3. Position your Banner or Window Sticker on your Glass by using blue painter's tape, with the transfer tape facing you
4. Lift up the sticker, without removing the blue painter's tape from your Glass
5. Carefully remove the backing of the sticker (plastic or paper), will need 1 person on each side of Windshield Banner
6. While one person is holding one side away from the glass, you will begin pressing the Transfer Tape/Sticker on windshield with your squeegee, start in the center & gradually work out to the sides
7. When it's all flat against Glass, carefully remove the Transfer Tape from the Vinyl Sticker. As the Transfer Tape begins to separate from the Vinyl Sticker, make sure the vinyl is sticking to the Glass and not the Transfer Tape. Once Transfer Tape is removed, if you see bubbles, you can use a heat gun, hair dryer, or let the sun work out the bubbles. If you use a heat gun or hair dryer, don't hold these items too close to the sticker or too long over one spot.
